IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS REGARDING OFFICIAL FINANCIAL DOCUMENTATION

- Official and original documents must be provided
- Photocopies and faxes will not be accepted
- All documents must be in English and in equivalent U.S. dollars (or the current exchange rate must be supplied by the bank). If not possible translations of the documents will be accepted if signed and sealed by an appropriate government or bank official
- All supporting documentation must be dated within one year of initial enrollment at the University of Wisconsin-Madison
- Attach a copy of the I-20 or DS-2019 from the last U.S. Institution attended, if applicable



SOURCES OF FUNDING

You can have multiple sources of funding. If *Total Funded Amount is not enough to cover expenses for the first year, it is the student's responsibility to show additional funding to cover those expenses. Securing funding for subsequent years of study is the responsibility of the student.

Sponsor (relative or friend): Full or Partial Funding

A sponsor can be a friend, acquaintance, or relative who is currently not on an F-1 or J-1 visa in the United States. A copy of this form is required for *each sponsor*.
